

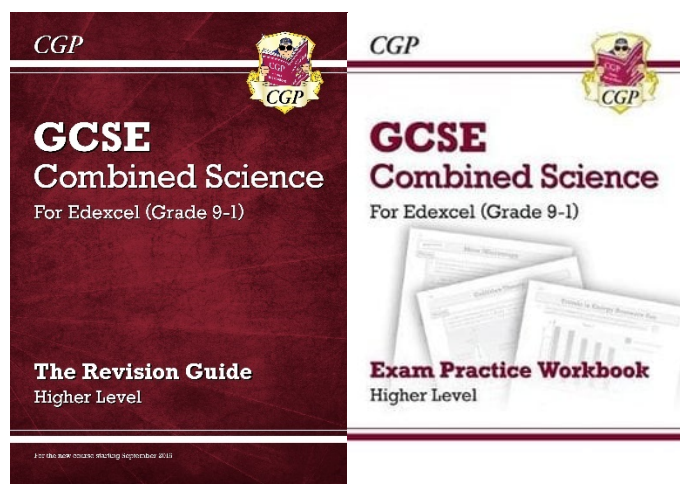
Combined Science GCSE 9-1
