Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to you following the Prime Minister, Boris Johnson's announcement last week regarding the easing of national restrictions. Whilst these measures are welcomed, at St Peter's we are continuing to work hard to keep everyone in our school community safe. Please see below for an update on these measures:

### Protective Measures

All of our existing COVID protective measures will remain in place (e.g. pupils and staff, sanitise and wash hands regularly.) [You can visit our website to read further details.](#)

### Face Coverings

There is evidence that the use of face coverings is an effective measure in preventing the spread and transmission of COVID-19. As such, we will continue to strongly encourage both staff and pupils to wear face coverings. Pupils must continue to wear face coverings on public transport, including school buses. In certain situations, pupils will be expected to wear a mask because of movement and interaction in the classroom.

### Home Testing

It is vitally important that pupils continue to home test twice weekly. Ideally, pupils should take their tests before school on Mondays and Thursdays. Preferably this would be in the morning before going to school. However, we understand that for some people this may be challenging. Therefore, tests can be taken the evening before school if needed.

You should follow NHS guidelines related to home testing (see the guidance leaflet inside the test box.) **If the result is positive you must contact the school office on 0161 248 1550.**
