I have read, understood and fully support the school Digital ICT Systems Responsible Use Code of Practice version 19, Addendum for Home Learning version 2 and Bring Your Own Device Code of Practice version 6 – for Pupils (available to read on St Peter's website and stpetersbook) and am aware of the consequences for any breach of these Codes of Practice.

I give permission for my child to use the school Digit ICT systems and access the Internet in a responsible manner. I understand that the school will take all reasonable precautions to ensure pupils cannot access inappropriate materials and that the school cannot be held responsible for the nature or content of materials accessed through the Internet.

1. I agree that the school is not liable for any damages arising from the use of the Internet facilities.
2. I am aware that my child's online behaviour should be responsible and lawful and that any online activity both in and out of school must not be used in a way that will cause the school, the staff, pupils or any member of the school community distress or cause any damage to the reputation of the school or its staff.
3. I also understand that pupils may bring their own devices to use at school at their own risk. Pupils are expected to act responsibly with regards to their own device, keeping it up to date and as secure as possible. It is their duty to be responsible for the upkeep and protection of their devices. St Peter's RC High School is in no way responsible for:
 - Personal devices that are broken while at school or during school-sponsored activities
 - Personal devices that are lost or stolen at school or during school-sponsored activities
 - Maintenance or upkeep of any personal device (keeping it charged, installing updates or upgrades, fixing any software or hardware issues).

I am aware that the school uses Google Apps for Education for pupils and as part of the Google terms and conditions the school is required to seek my permission for my child to have a Google Apps for Education account. I understand the school presently uses the following: Google Calendar, Google Docs, Google Sites. I agree to my child using G Suite (Google Apps for Education), which includes Google classroom to message members of staff on issues relating only to schoolwork in accordance with the guidance in this Code of Practice. I am also aware that all pupils have an Office 365 account including Microsoft TEAMS and are obliged to abide by the rules governing this account.
