Re: Year 11 Study Leave

Dear parent/carer,

Following consultation with students, we have decided to bring forward **Study Leave** by one week to allow pupils to only come in for exams the week beginning **Monday 8th June**, rather than stay in school all day. As we near the end of the exam season, students feel time would be better spent working independently from home, preparing for their remaining exams.

Pupils will need to attend in **full school uniform**. For morning exams, they need to be here by 8.45am and afternoon exams 12.45pm. They will be expected to make their own way home following each morning exam. There is only one day where students may have morning and afternoon exams and they will stay in school and have lunch as usual, taking the school bus home if needed.
